

Job Description: Orienteering Technical Specialist

The Foothills Wanderers Orienteering Club will be hiring one or more Technical Specialists over the course of the 2008 orienteering season. Each Technical Specialist will have the opportunity to contribute to various projects according their specialized skills. These projects include:

- a) revamp of officials courses, including an **immediate need** to produce a new FWOC C-Meet Officials course (material available from similar EOOOC course), and possibly other portions of a new COF Officials course
- b) teaching of the C-Meet and Level 1 officials courses described above
- c) group coaching, primarily in providing interesting drills for at least 4 Wednesday evening sessions, and several sessions in the forest
- d) creation of instructional materials, such as: "how to" brochures, etc

Skills Required

- i. 2 or more years of experience in the sport of orienteering
- ii. computer literacy, including proficiency with OCAD for modifying maps and either OCAD or Condes for course setting
- iii. experience and/or certification in the following areas will be a definite asset: orienteering officials; NCCP coaching; first aid
